FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS **LEMOYNE COLLEGE PARTNERSHIP**

- 1) **What does this partnership with LeMoyne College entail?** Christ The King Retreat House will be providing housing for LeMoyne College students that need quarantine. Student's will be provided a safe space to live and eat that is separate from the rest of the student population.
- 2) **What does it mean when you say, "students that are in need of quarantine"?** According to New York State Governor Andrew Cuomo, any student who comes from a state that is on their mandatory quarantine list is required to quarantine for a period of 14 days. Christ The King would serve as a place for those students and other students who require quarantine.
- 3) **Are you taking in any students that have knowingly tested positive for Covid-19?** No. CTK is not serving as an isolation house for individuals that test positive for Covid-19.
- 4) **What does this mean for groups that have retreats or conferences scheduled this fall?** All retreats and conferences scheduled until November 29th have been cancelled.
- 5) **I am a group leader and you have cancelled my retreat/conference. Do I get a refund on my deposit that I submitted?** CTK would be more than happy to refund your deposit. We also encourage you to work with our Executive Director Chris Spilka on using that deposit to schedule a future retreat/conference. We want to create new memories with you in the future!
- 6) **Are you allowing any guests onto your campus?** Due to the sensitive nature of working with students that are in quarantine, we are temporarily closing off our entire facility to all outside guests. This includes individual overnight retreat guests, day guests and visitors who purchase items from our gift shop.
- 7) **Will individuals be able to walk around the beautiful grounds of CTK?** Unfortunately, no. All our walking paths and our pool will be closed to outside guests as well.
- 8) **When will you be reopening?** November 30th is our target date to open back up to outside guests. As of today, we will proceed with all scheduled retreats after that date.
- 9) **Do you anticipate having group overnight retreats after you reopen?** Due to the fluid nature of this pandemic we are unsure what our winter months will look like regarding allowing large overnight retreats. We did however experience great success with our day retreats and individual overnight retreats. CTK encourages you to book your retreat and they will waive the deposit, so it poses no financial risk to you. We encourage all group leaders and guests to frequently visit our website for the most up to date information.
